I will not damage a living tree, shrubs, or other natural features.

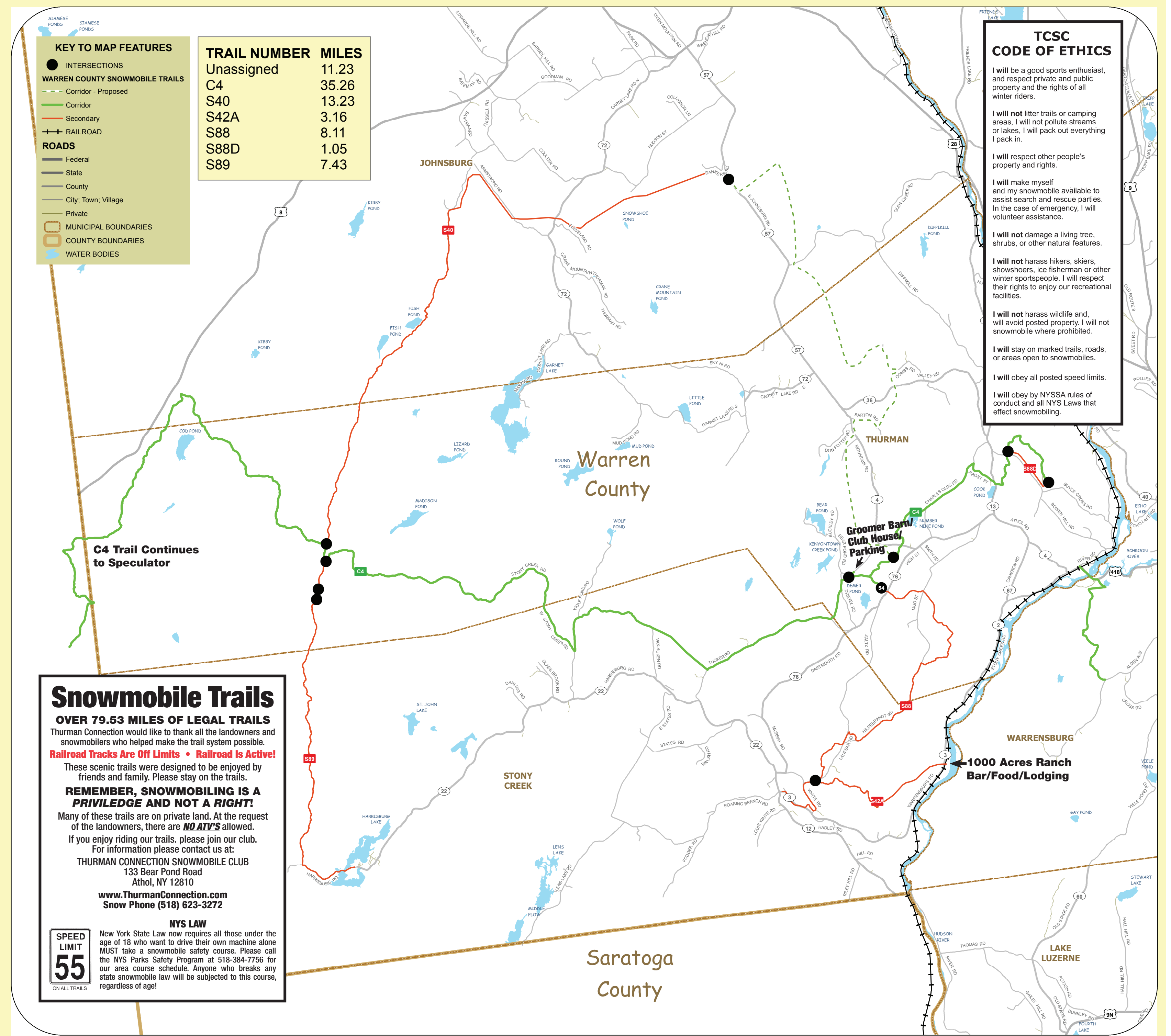
I will not harass hikers, skiers, showshoers, ice fisherman or other winter sportspeople. I will respect their rights to enjoy our recreational facilities.

I will not harass wildlife and, will avoid posted property. I will not snowmobile where prohibited.

I will obey all posted speed limits.

I will obey by NYSSA rules of conduct and all NYS Laws that effect snowmobiling.

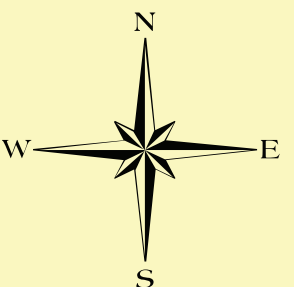
